- Afternoon: Application of final coats for various finishes, followed by an introduction to soaps, waxes, and sealers for finishes.
- End of Lesson (4:00 PM)

#### Day 3

- Morning & Afternoon (8:30 AM 4:00 PM): Execute a sample for the final exam. Review of materials, pricing examples, and working out estimates for stucco and marmorino.
- Final Examination: Conducted by a panel of professional specialists.
